INTRODUCTION

In my travels and ministering in over 60 countries two questions are prevalent on people's hearts.
Have I got the Holy Ghost?
What is my position in the body of Christ?

This booklet "Understanding The Place Where Your Lot Falleth" (Gifts And Callings) is compiled as a help to knowing your gifts and position in the body of Christ. It does not replace the supernatural element of positional placing in the body of Christ.

I want to mention one of the most important elements to finding your position in the body of Christ is to receive the Baptism of the Holy Ghost first then Divine love comes.

The Works That I Do Bear Witness Of Me 51-0413

E-38 So friends, find Divine love and favor with God.

Then God, if He finds favor with you, will give His gifts into you. But first, find the Giver. Seek the Giver, then the gifts will come as God sees fit to give it to you. Do you believe that?

So now, when you go around like this, and different people seeking all night for gifts and things like that, go back till you find love, till you shake hands with your brother across the street then. Then we'll talk more about getting the gifts then. That's right. When you get the love of God in your heart, then you talk about the gifts.

Our pattern for positional placing is set in the Old Testament as the children of Israel were possessing their inheritance. The tribes boundaries had been revealed by the Word.

Exodus 23:20, 31 Behold, I send an Angel before thee, to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared. 31 And I will set thy bounds from the Red sea even unto the sea of the Philistines, and from the desert unto the river: for I will deliver the inhabitants of the land into your hand; and thou shalt drive them out before thee.

As the tribes of the children of Israel begin to possess the boundaries of their inheritance the next stage was made known. The Lord was revealing the pattern for the individuals in the tribe to find their place.

Joshua 14:1-2,5 KJVS

1 And these are the countries which the children of Israel inherited in the land of Canaan, which Eleazar the priest, and Joshua the son of Nun, and the heads of the fathers of the tribes of the children of Israel, distributed for inheritance to them.

2 By lot was their inheritance, as the Lord commanded by the hand of Moses, for the nine tribes, and for the half tribe.

5 As the Lord commanded Moses, so the children of Israel did, and they divided the land.

A lot (area or measure) was supernaturally discerned.

Joshua 18:10-11 KJVS

10 And Joshua cast lots for them in Shiloh before the Lord : and there Joshua divided the land unto the children of Israel according to their divisions.

11 And the lot of the tribe of the children of Benjamin came up according to their families: and the coast of their lot came forth between the children of Judah and the children of Joseph.

1 Chronicles 26:12-14 KJVS

12 Among these were the divisions of the porters, even among the chief men, having wards one against another, to minister in the house of the Lord.

13 And they cast lots, as well the small as the great, according to the house of their fathers, for every gate.

14 And the lot eastward fell to Shelemiah. Then for Zechariah his son, a wise counsellor, they cast lots; and his lot came out northward.

With this pattern established in the Old Testament we can see the same in the New Testament.

Israel's inheritance was a natural land. Ours is a spiritual land.

The boundaries of the land is revealed in the Word.

Romans 12:3-8 KJVS

3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

4 For as we have many members in one body, and all members have not the same office:

5 So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another.

6 Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith;

7 Or ministry, let us wait on our ministering: or he that teacheth, on teaching;

8 Or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that sheweth mercy, with cheerfulness.

1 Corinthians 12:1,4-14 KJVS

1 Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I would not have you ignorant. [4] Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.
5 And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord.
6 And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all.
7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.
8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;
9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;
10 To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:
11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.
12 For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.
13 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.
14 For the body is not one member, but many.

Each individual is given a measure of faith (lot) and a measure of the gift of Christ. Individuals can have the same gift but have a different measure of the gift.

Ephesians 4:7 *But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ.*

Ministerial gifts.

Ephesians 4:11 KJVS

11 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;

Deacons.

1 Timothy 3:8-10 KJVS

8 Likewise must the deacons be grave, not doubletongued, not given to much wine, not greedy of filthy lucre;
9 Holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience.
10 And let these also first be proved; then let them use the office of a deacon, being found blameless.

Trustees

Acts 6:1 *And in those days, when the number of the disciples was multiplied, there arose a murmuring of the Grecians against the Hebrews, because their widows were neglected in the daily ministration.*

2 Then the twelve called the multitude of the disciples unto them, and said, *It is not reason that we should leave the word of God, and serve tables.*
3 Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business.

Worshippers, musicians, singers song writers, technicians.

The boundaries of our inheritance is revealed in the Word.

Understanding that the boundaries are not our limitations but the possibilities of what we can achieve we can determine more accurately what land suits our characteristics and personalities.

By comparing ourselves with characters in the bible who have these gifts, we can determine the kind of gifts and calling we can achieve.

1 Peter 2:9 KJVS

9 *But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:*

As Joshua 14 has revealed Eleazar the priest (local pastor) with the urimthummin (discernment) Joshua a type of THE Holy Ghost and the heads of the fathers of the tribes (elders, fathers of children) are to divide the land by lot or to the individuals in the body of Christ.

We pray this booklet could assist you to Understand The Place Where Your Lot Falleth.

May our Lord Jesus Christ quicken these things and bring understanding to all that would read.

Character: Joseph

Scriptures: Genesis 41:1-37

Scene (How they used the gift): Wisdom to find favour in any environment or circumstance; had understanding in interpretation of dreams and wisdom to know how to bring it to pass

Character: Wise hearted women

Scriptures: Exodus 35:25-26

Scene (How they used the gift): Wisdom to spin goat hair on the live goat to retain the lustrous colours making the material unique and special for the presence of the Lord in the tabernacle

Character: Wise hearted men

Scriptures: Exodus 36:1

Scene (How they used the gift): Did all manner of cunning work and craft for the service of the Lord in the sanctuary. Wisdom to work with all materials

Knowledge is the spirit of Prophecy; ability to tap into God's foreknowledge; having a clear understanding

Character: Moses

Scriptures: Genesis to Deuteronomy

Scene (How they used the gift): Wrote the first five books of the bible . Gave the law to the levites and the people.

Character: Adam

Scriptures: Genesis 2: 20, 23

Scene (How they used the gift): Named the animals etc. Had an understanding of marriage.

Character: Abel

Scriptures: Genesis 4: 4

Scene (How they used the gift): He had the foreknowledge of God and understood the plan of redemption, the sacrifice that needed to be slain – redemption by blood

Character: Noah

Scriptures: Genesis 6:13-21

Scene (How they used the gift): He knew that the flood would come and how to build the ark, God's provided way of escape 120 years before judgement struck.

Character: Abraham

Scriptures: Genesis 15:4

Scene (How they used the gift): He knew the promise of the Lord (his seed shall be as the stars); the gift of knowledge through the promise, which activated the spoken word, 'I and the lad will go yonder and worship and come again to you' (Genesis 22:5)

Scene (How they used the gift): She knew that the bondwoman & her son should not be heirs.

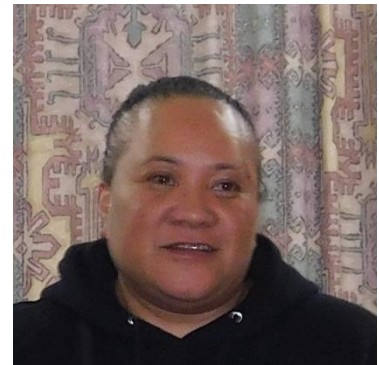

Scene (How they used the gift): Asked the right things for the Lord's great people

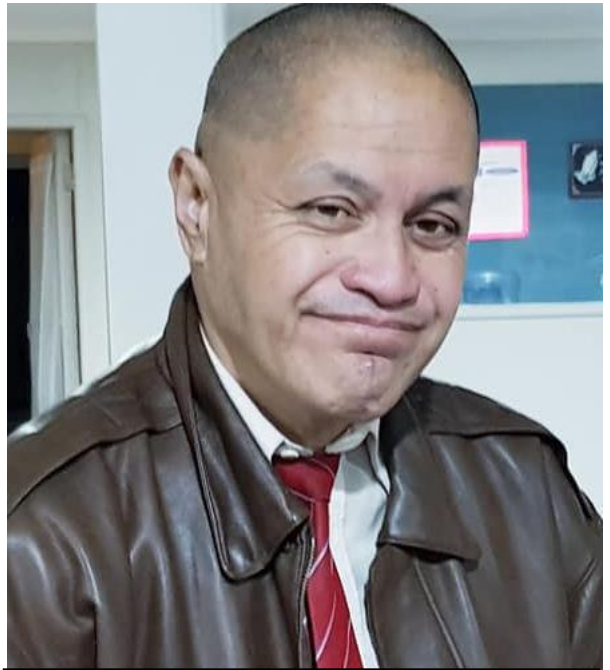

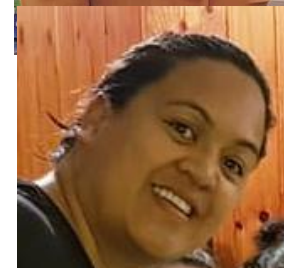

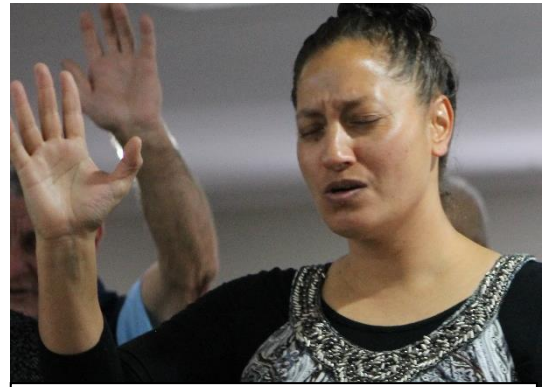
